Which Country Do You Think This is?

Politically stable, economically vibrant, culturally cohesive, constitutionally democratic, governmentally by law, diplomatically influential, geopolitically peaceful, demographically homogeneous, individually hardworking, educationally meritocracy, spiritually conservative; is there still such a country in the current polarizing world? Which country would be the first to come to your mind if there still is one?

Very few people would guess Hungary. On April 3rd, Viktor Orban led his party, Fidesz, for the fourth time in a row to win the parliamentary election in Hungary, and this time by a wide margin against the six united opposing parties. Hearing the news, I couldn't help but to recall my first trip to Hungary in 2017. At the time the Hungarian government was feuding openly with the Hungarian American investor/activist George Soros.
